Dear SouthPole-*sium* registrant,

We will be gathering in Oslo in just 5 days!

This may be the last Update to go out.

We presently have 65 persons registered, two more than were registered for Scotland in 2015.

- The Optional Excursion on Friday to Uranienborg, Amundsen's house, will start from the National Library. You can see the details at <http://www.antarctic-circle.org/gathering3-uranienborg.htm>

36 are signed up for this.

We will gather from 9:15am onward at the National Library. We will be welcomed with coffee and tea. The program will begin at 9am.

The Excursion will proceed by bus at 10:30am.

The program at the National Library is open to anyone without cost whether or not you are continuing on the Excursion.

- Although we can accommodate more people on the bus on the Excursion to Uranienborg, we may have difficulty in increasing the number at lunch. For latecomers we will lower the price and ask them to order off the menu elsewhere in the restaurant.

- On Friday, unless the Optional Excursion returns from Uranienborg earlier than planned, we should be back in central Oslo by 5pm. We have asked that The Park Inn be the terminus. The Opening Reception is at 7pm so those going will take the Ferry or Bus 30 to the Museum.

- The Optional Excursion to Sandefjord on Monday also can accommodate more people. It will be possible to increase the lunch numbers. I'm hoping that the bus will depart from The Park Hotel as many of us will be staying there. We probably won't know that for sure until we gather on Friday at the opening reception.

- The Saturday night dinner on the *Fram* will follow a Reception that starts at 7pm.

The building that houses the *Fram* is kept cool so you should dress with that in mind. Some will wear a coat & tie or a dress, but others won't. It's strictly up to you. Some will not have the time or opportunity to go back to their hotels to change so don't feel that you have to dress up.
